Academy Recruitment & Talent Hub

Through our continued partnership working via the NWL Health & Social Care Skills Academy we have created a bespoke hub for our local communities to be supported to access vacancies in our Trusts. The programme is designed to help local people become: informed, prepared and interview ready to access entry levels roles. The Hub is designed to align with our NHS workforce plan, widening participation agenda and anchor priorities across NWL. To date, we have engaged with 120 local people, 77 applying for the programme and 32 people supported through recruitent process.

• Clinical Skills Study Day

The North West London Health & Social Care Academy, in partnership with Central London Community Healthcare NHS Trust, held a Clinical Skills Study Day on 2nd September and 11th October for registered and unregistered care home staff. The day attracted 60 participants who gained valuable clinical skills training. The positive feedback received, including requests for further training, highlights the programme's impact on improving care home staff's capabilities.

In collaboration with Morley College, the Academy hosted a unique event that brought together a diverse range of health and social care employers under one roof. • NWL Midwifery OSCE Training Programme

In cooperation with our NWL partner Trusts, the Academy has recently launched the first sector-wide training programme for Internationally Educated Midwives preparing for their OSCE. The programme consists of three weeks combined teaching and simulated practice facilitated by clinical educators. It not only equips the midwives with the required competencies to prepare for their NMC exams but further provides pastoral care and networking opportunities with colleagues from NWL undergoing the same process. The first cohort of 6 midwives appreciated in particular the opportunity to exercise mock exam scenarios in the simulation suite and subsequently reported their level of confidence in passing the OSCE has increased.
